What is it?

The scheme provides doctors in training with the unique opportunity to spend one year working with the most senior leaders in national healthcare-affiliated organisations to develop their skills in:

leadership | management | strategy | project management | health policy

Fellows are immersed at the centre of organisations such as NHS England and NHS Improvement, Health Education England, GMC, BUPA, NICE and Macmillan Cancer Support. The scheme is sponsored by NHS England and NHS Improvement's National Medical Director and is managed by the Faculty of Medical Leadership and Management.

Am I eligible?

The scheme is open to doctors in training from all specialties who have completed both years of foundation training and have not gained CCT by 1 September. See the FMLM website for full eligibility criteria.

How does this work with my training?

Successful candidates take up the fellowship as an Out of Programme Experience (OOPE, or equivalent) and are seconded from their employer to the organisation that will host them as a clinical fellow.
