### **Main Duties**

The Glenfield Hospital is a Tertiary Cardiology Centre with expertise in the management of complex cardiological conditions. F1 doctors will gain experience in managing common cardiovascular conditions such as ischaemic heart disease, heart failure, arrhythmias, and valvular heart disease. There is the opportunity to see more complex cardiology (e.g., transcatheter valve intervention, electrophysiology and devices, coronary intervention, stress, and transoesophageal echo). There is opportunity to develop outpatient consultation skills under direct consultant supervision. F1 doctors undertake OOH experience on the Cardio-respiratory Medical Admissions Unit (CDU) and the Coronary Care Unit. Trainees may also participate in research and audit activity on the firm. Each F1 is allocated a dedicated clinical supervisor who is ward based.
