It provides valuable experience in a holistic, hands-on approach to patient care, focusing on tracheostomy management, disability care, and the management of neurological conditions. Additionally, this role allows clinicians to enhance their neurological examination skills while addressing a range of medical issues.</p> <p>Working hours are from 9 AM to 5 PM, with clinical supervision available at all times. Doctors will gain valuable experience working with patients who have communication difficulties, developing their skills in addressing these challenges effectively. The role emphasizes a multidisciplinary team (MDT) approach, offering collaboration with various healthcare professionals to provide comprehensive care.</p> <p>This is an excellent opportunity for clinicians to broaden their understanding of physical and cognitive deficits, along with important aspects like mental capacity assessments and best interest decisions. Foundation Doctors will also have the chance to refine interventional skills such as spasticity and pain management through Ultrasound-guided intramuscular injections and nerve blocks.</p> <p>The team is committed to providing the necessary support and supervision to help Foundation Doctors advance their careers, develop practical skills, and gain a deeper understanding of holistic, patient-centred care.</p>
