Main Duties					
<p>Leicester General hospital is a large elective orthopaedic unit and is the 5/6<sup>th</sup> largest unit for hip/knee replacements in the UK. All orthopaedic subspecialties are covered. There is senior supervision all of the time. There is a departmental induction ½ day at the start of the rotation. The clinical work allows ample chances for workplace-based assessments to be performed. There is a monthly audit/morbidity/mortality meeting.</p> <p>The F2 main duties is to look after ward patients coming in for planned orthopaedic operations. They also attend preassessment assessing patients' fitness for surgery and liaising with other specialities if needed. They are also rostered ward rounds led by a registrar level doctor on a daily basis. They attend theatres, assist in a variety of orthopaedic procedures, and have ample chance to perform the simpler part of the operations like wound closure. They also do day on calls weekdays and weekends, but do not do any night shifts.</p>
